Dissertations and Theses--Full Text (Proquest)

Index of all doctoral dissertations and some master's theses from most North American and many European colleges and universities. Dissertations published from 1980 forward include 350-word abstracts written by the author. Master's theses published from 1988 forward include 150-word abstracts.

Includes full text of dissertations from 1996 to present. NOTE: Some full text is not available due to restrictions placed by the author, patents pending or problems regarding use of copyrighted material without permission.

Ethnic Newswatch

Full-text articles from the ethnic and minority press in America, covering over 180 newspapers and magazines, representing African American, Asian American, Hispanic/Latino/Chicano, Jewish, Native American, Arab American, and European American history and culture. Coverage: 1990 - Present.

<u>Humanities International Complete</u>

Index of the humanities literature, including archaeology, art, classical studies, folklore, history, journalism, language and literature, linguistics, performing arts, political criticism, philosophy, and religion. Coverage: 1984 to present.

LEXIS-NEXIS ACADEMIC UNIVERSE

A full-text newspaper and journal index. Use the General News/Arts and Sports section to find reviews.

An American Ballroom Companion: Dance Instruction Manuals, ca. 1400-1920. (Library of Congress American Memory Project). presents a collection of over two hundred social dance manuals at the Library of Congress. The list begins with a rare late fifteenth-century source, Les basses danses de Marguerite d'Autriche (c.1490) and ends with Ella Gardner's 1929 Public dance halls, their regulation and place in the recreation of adolescents. Along with dance instruction manuals, this online presentation also includes a significant number of antidance manuals, histories, treatises on etiquette, and items. Many of the manuals also provide historical information on theatrical dance.
